From 2010, the journal of the Society for Francophone Postcolonial Studies will become an annual, book-length, hardback publication. The Association for the Study of Caribbean and African Literature in French (ASCALF) was the precursor of the Society for Francophone Postcolonial Studies and it was one of the main pioneers of Francophone Studies in Britain and Ireland. ASCALF's publications, *ASCALF Bulletin* and *ASCALF Yearbook* aimed both to disseminate the research work presented at ASCALF's annual conferences and day workshops, and to publish other innovative material in the field of Francophone postcolonial literature: 25 issues of the *ASCALF Bulletin* (issues 1-3 and 16-17 are no longer available), and 5 issues of the *ASCALF Yearbook* (issues 1 and 2 are no longer available) were published. These publications include articles by prominent scholars in the field, such as Celia Britton, Patrick Corcoran, Mary Gallagher, Peter Hawkins, Bridget Jones, Roger Little, Pius Ngandu Nkashama, Mireille Rosello, Andy Stafford, Michael Syrotinski, as well as interviews with writers such as Tanella Boni, Azouz Begag and Ahmadou Kourouma.
